Thank you for your cooperation as we continue to respond to the challenge of Coronavirus.

It has been lovely to welcome everyone back to school during the week. We hope your child has enjoyed returning to face-to-face learning in class. If you feel your child is concerned about any aspect of the return to school then please contact me immediately.

Dogs near the school - there has been an increase in the number of dogs seen near the school since the lock down. Please remember that some pupils are very scared of dogs. Please consider this when bringing your dog / dogs to the school area in the morning and at the end of the day.

Arriving at school on time - some parents / carers are beginning to show a pattern of arriving late at school fairly regularly. This needs to be improved – please ensure that every pupil is on the school campus before the bell rings at 9 o'clock.

Easter Holidays - the school will close for the Easter holidays at 3.30 on Friday, March 26th and re-open on Monday April 12th.

Breakfast Club Arrangements - The Breakfast Club will be open immediately after the Easter break (starting at 8.15)

Masks - all parents and visitors to the site need to wear a mask at all times. This includes parents / carers when escorting and collecting their children from school. Parents are also kindly requested to distance themselves socially when assembling. Staff wear masks in classes if they cannot keep 2 meters away from the children or other adults.

Symptoms - anyone with Covid-19 symptoms should stay home immediately, order a test and inform the school. The whole household needs to be isolated until the test result is known.

Symptoms include high temperature, a new persistent cough and loss or a change in sense of smell or taste. Other early symptoms may include headaches, general tiredness and vomiting and usually flu-related pains.
